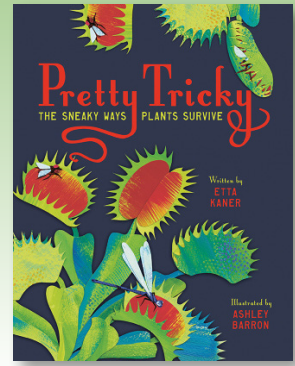

WHO'S WHO IN ETTA'S GARDEN?

COLEUS

This plant loves shade.



OSTRICH FERNS

These often get as tall as Etta!



LUNGWORT

This is one of the first plants to come up in the spring. It has both purple and pink flowers on the same plant!



LADY'S MANTLE

These leaves are hydrophobic. Water droplets bead up on them and look like pearls.



BLUE HOSTA

Not all leaves are green!



CRANESBILL

This plant gets its name from the shape of its seed pods, which look like the long pointy beak of a crane.



IRIS

This plant has pretty purple and yellow flowers that remind Etta of the hair on a poodle's head.



CALA LILY

Bet you've never seen triangular shaped leaves!



HOSTA

This is a giant hosta with really fragrant white flowers.
