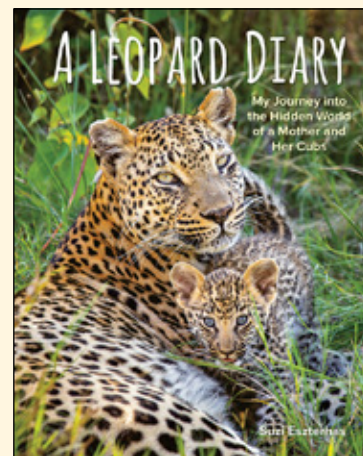
How Nature Keeps Us Guessing

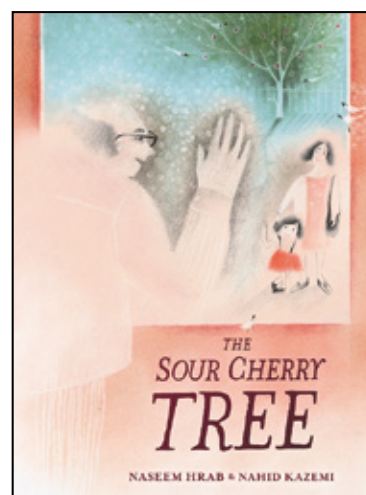
How to Party Like a Snail
