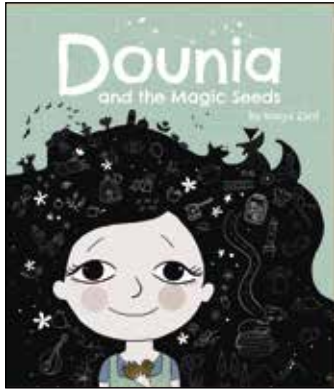

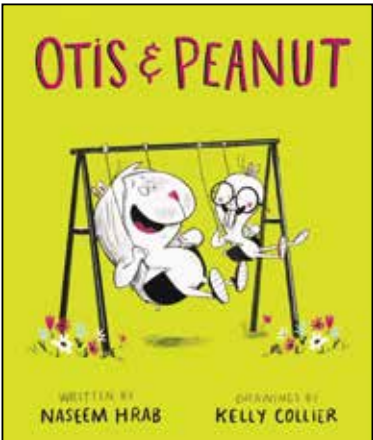

Otis & Peanut

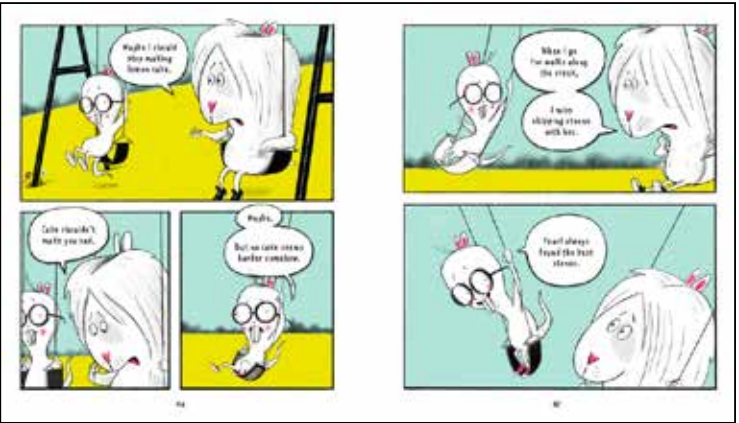
