At first, she is afraid of the responsibility and the chiefs doubt her; they complain that she skips meetings to spend time in the village. But Abioye is getting to know her people and their needs, making changes along the way. When the chiefs call for a new king, the villagers refuse to vote for any of the men. Under Abioye's rule, the village has flourished and, for the first time, the village claims a female king. This empowering story explores themes of service in leadership, gaining respect rather than demanding it, and gender equality.

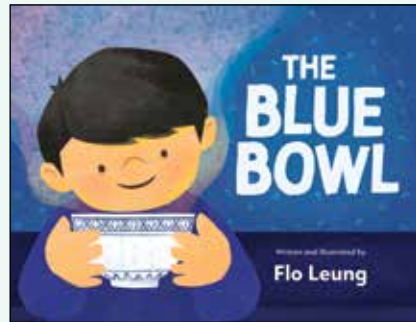

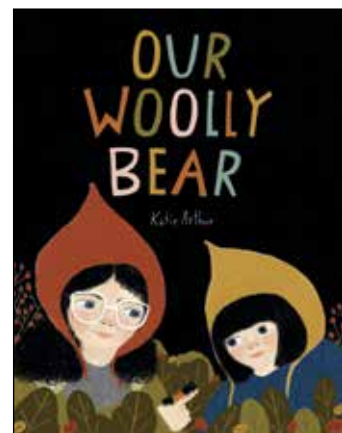

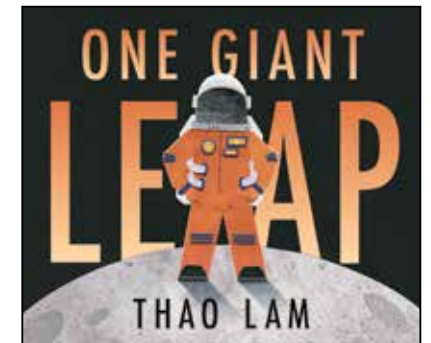

This story explores themes of outdoor discovery and playful curiosity, offering a welcome reminder that beauty often surfaces in small, slow moments, and that change persists even when the world seems still.

Stepping outside, the child transforms into a colourful astronaut venturing out into a stark, dark landscape, and presses heavy boots into the ground. The little astronaut sets off and is undeterred by the obstacles and creatures they meet as they climb, jump, and plant a triumphant flag. An ode to a child's imagination, this wordless book takes us along one child's exciting journey to show us how something as simple as a walk to school can become an out-of-this-world adventure.

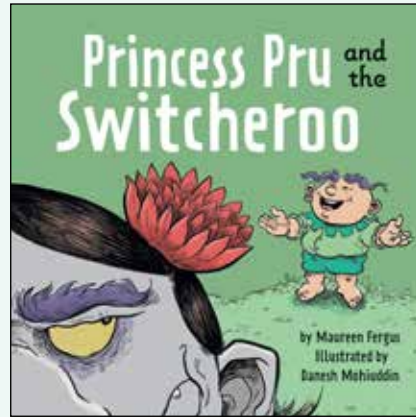

But when a dragon swoops in to kidnap the “princess,” their plans quickly go awry. This fearsomely funny sequel to *Princess Pru and the Ogre on the Hill* is an unconventional fairy tale about empathy, inclusivity, and being mindful of the things we sometimes take for granted.



## Wake Up, Little Pin! The Story of a Sleepy Sapling

When Mother Pin, the hub tree of a deciduous forest, wakes to crisp, spring air but cannot seem to stir Little Pin Oak beside her, she asks the plants and animals around them for help. Little by little, the forest awakens and comes to Little Pin’s aid: fungi pass on nutrients through their underground network, bushes and grasses share healthy sugars, and the sun lends its energy. Soon, when the collective forest has given as much as it can, Little Pin wakes up, ready for spring! A picture book celebrating the reciprocal relationship between plant and animal communities in forest ecosystems.

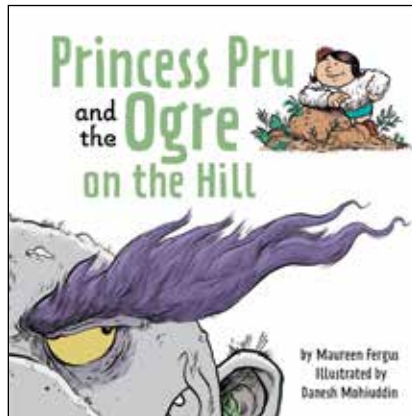
