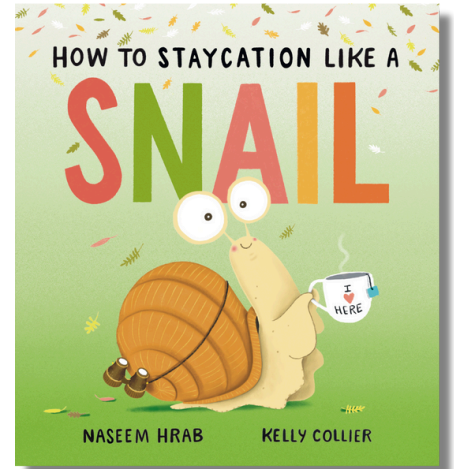

- If you could go anywhere, where would you go?
- Do you know what a staycation is? How would you describe it?

After Reading:

Reflection—Text-to-Self

- Snail says he feels overwhelmed on faraway adventures. Can you relate to his feeling? Why or why not?
- Would you like to have a staycation? Why or why not?

Reflection—Text-to-World

- Why might a person choose a staycation instead of a vacation?
(ex. weather, illness, cost, convenience, time, etc.)
