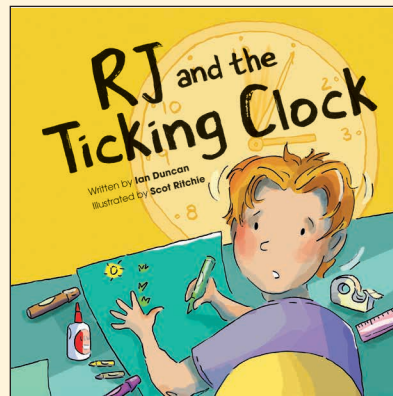
It Began with a Buzz

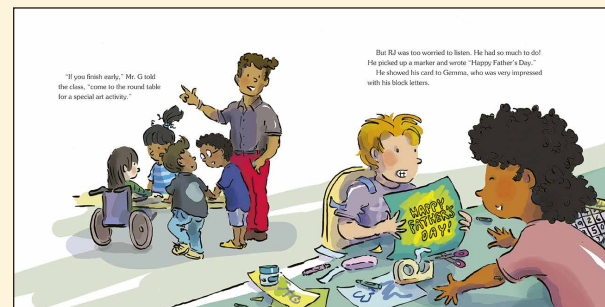

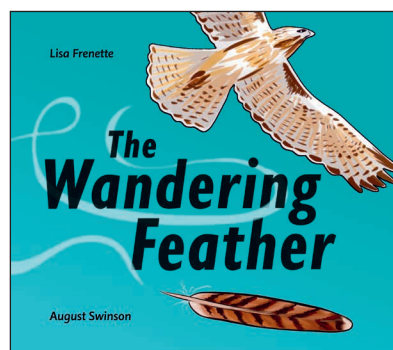

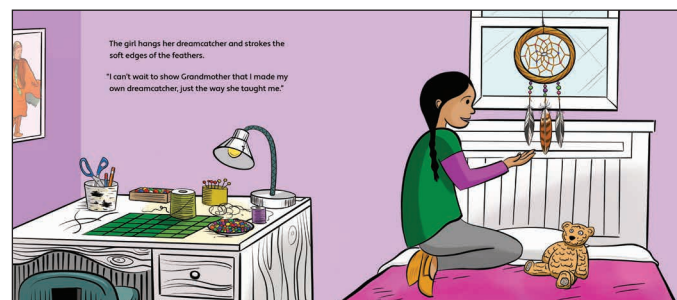
The Wandering Feather
