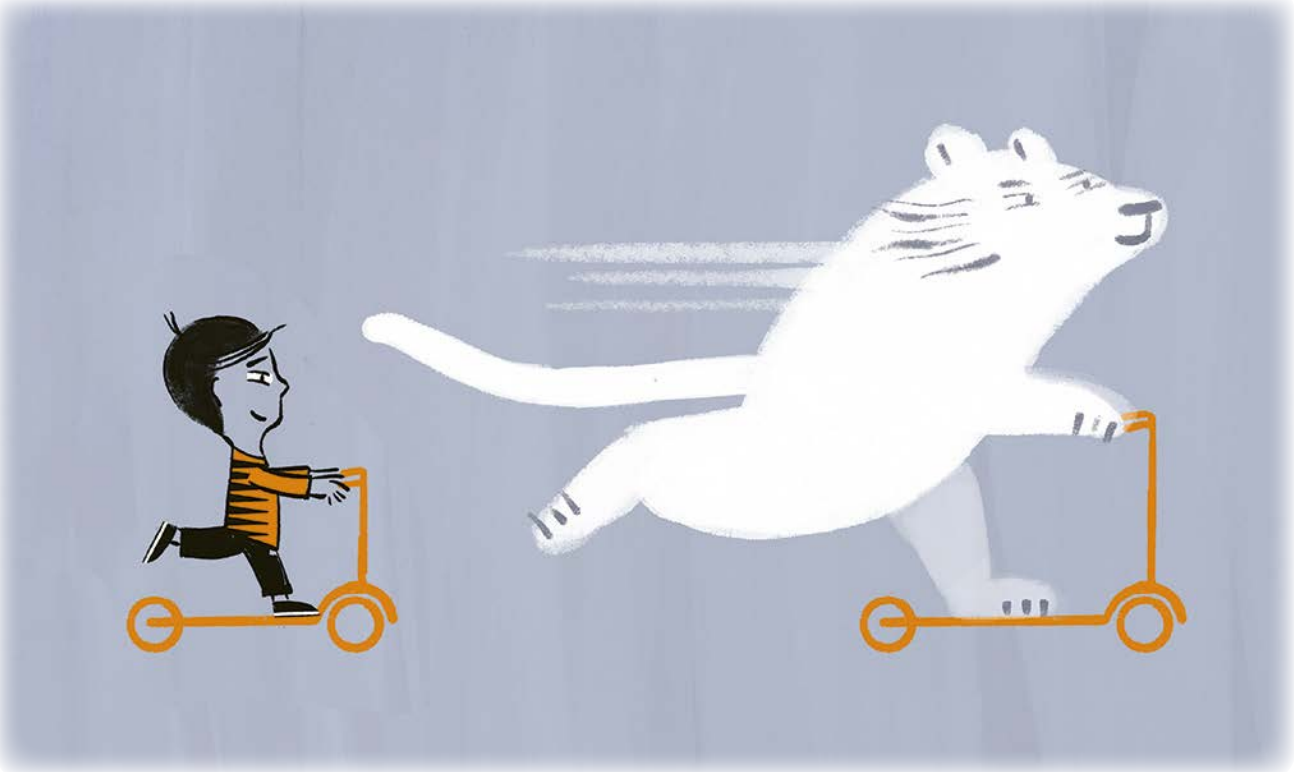
You Can't Tame a Tiger

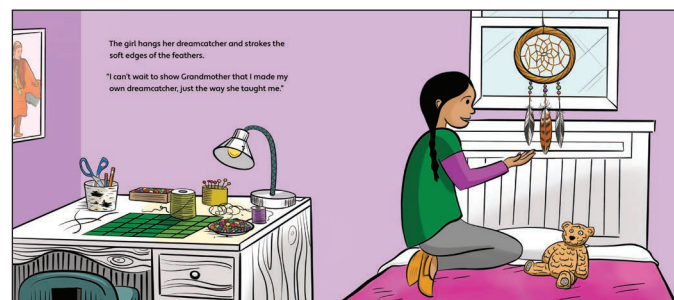
## The Wandering Feather
