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Fifty years ago, the Young Naturalist Foundation launched *OWL* magazine for kids 8–12. *OWL* was an acronym for “Outdoors and Wildlife,” and the magazine was designed to develop a love of the environment and scientific discovery in its readers. In the five decades since, the company became Owlkids, expanding its vision and mandate, and launching two other children’s magazines—*Chickadee* in 1978 and *Chirp* in 1997—and a book division. Since 1976, Owlkids has kept kids front and centre, creating content that engages, informs, and inspires a love of reading and learning.

Like the magazines, Owlkids Books respects children’s intelligence, imagination, and curiosity. Our list includes a diversity of voices and experiences, and it is recognized for its signature energy, creativity, sense of humour, and thematic relevance. Our books have garnered a range of accolades including major reviews, best-of-the-year lists, and awards recognition, and they’ve been licensed in more than 20 languages around the world.

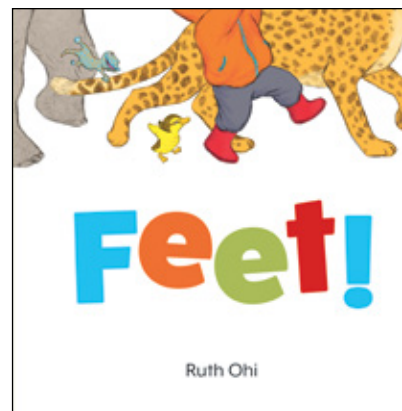


**Giving a

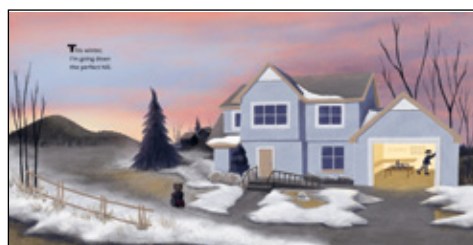
The Perfect Ride

Over time, the blanket's layers grow thin, but new cloth is added, and new stories are embroidered into the cotton fabric. Each time the blanket passes to its next owner, it carries forward a growing tapestry of family history.



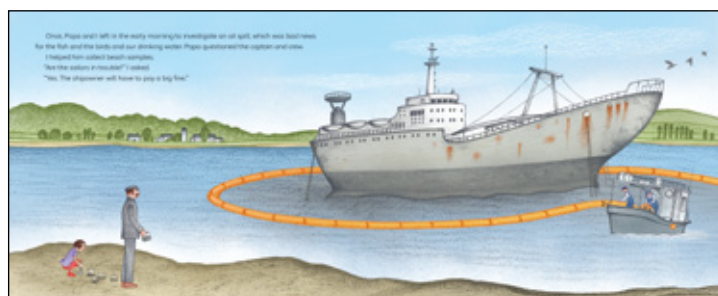

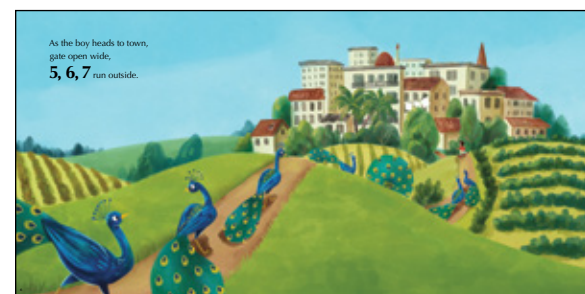
A Party of Peacocks
